PREFACE.

THE Authorized, or King James, Version of the Holy in 1611. In February, 1870, the Convocation of Canterbury to consider the subject of revising the Authorized Version. in the following terms:

"That it is desirable that a revision of the Authorized Scriptures be undertaken. That the revision be so conducted as to preserve the marginal renderings, and such emendations as it may be in the text of the Authorized Version. That in the absence of any new translation of the Bible, or any other, except where, in the judgment of the most competent necessary. That in such necessary changes the style of the existing version be closely followed."

The report was adopted and two companies were formed to revise the Authorized Version of the Old and the New Testaments by the most distinguished Biblical scholars in Europe and America.

The revision of the New Testament was undertaken in 1881. The revision of the Old Testament was completed in 1885. Universal interest was awakened by the publication of the Revised Version. The judgment of the most critical scholars of the day was in favor of a more accurate representation of the original Hebrew and Greek.

Large Family Bibles are published, which contain the Revised Version in parallel columns. Valuable as these copies of the Holy Scriptures are, they are nevertheless inconvenient for use by Sunday-school teachers and for a hand Bible for ready reference. The great value of the Revised Version, also containing the Self-Pronouncing feature, and for convenient use, is evident at a glance.

This New Edition of the Holy Scriptures possesses all the advantages offered to Bible readers and students. It is a Self-Pronouncing Bible containing the King James and the Revised Versions on the same page.

There can be no doubt that a careful comparison of the Revised Version must be of great interest and value to all who are specially interested in the Bible. It is especially true that this must be the case with Sunday-school teachers. The cause of the great popularity of Parallel Bibles, in which the two versions are printed side by side in parallel columns.

The Self-Pronouncing Combination Bible is a combination of the King James and the Revised Versions, while it contains
