History of the Bible: In 1996 the bible was in the possession of Rubie Plant Butterworth of Tallahassee, FL, a descendant of Flavius A. Byrd. Janet Laurie Byrd was Rubie Plant Butterworth's mother. She also stated: "Nathan Byrd, my great-great-grandfather was an early settler of Miccosukee, as were Blakes and Parrishes. He served as a delegate to the Constitutional Convention (if my memory serves me correctly)." The title page was provided, although the date is not clear.

Additional Materials: Two handwritten loose pages containing additional family lineage information, about the Blake family, were provided.

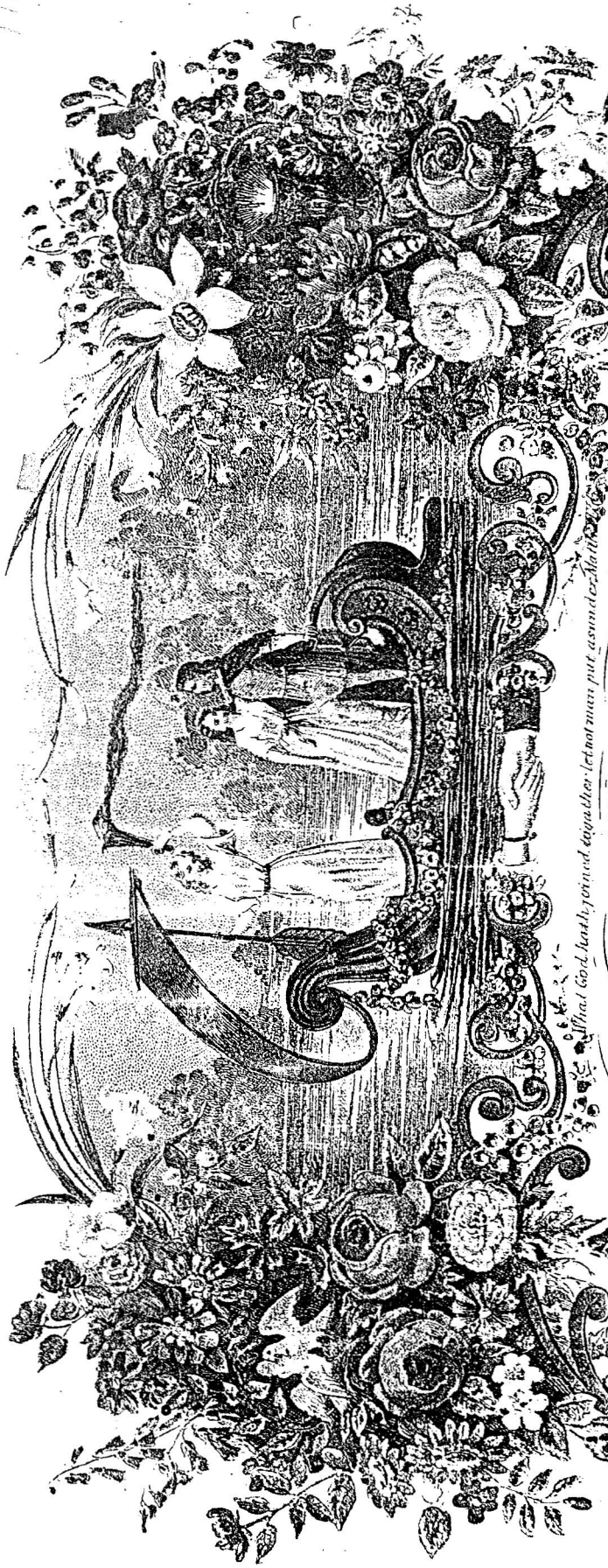

Isham Blake, the earliest known Blake of this family, is of Scotch Irish descent. Born in 1765 in Southampton Co. Virginia. He married Mary Macy Clifton, Scotch descent, of Southeastern Va. He died in Fayetteville, N.C. in 1830.

As he was too young to enter the Revolutionary war he joined the band as a fifer. At the close of the war he was body-guard to La Fayette.
