History of the Bible: In 1997 the bible was in the possession of Jane Reynolds Harris and John Flanigan Harris, of Tallahassee, FL . John F. Harris is the great-grandson of Leroy Campbell Caldwell on his mother's side. The Bible was a graduation present from Trinity College NC on 14 June 1877, to Leroy Campbell Caldwell, who later became an attorney, judge, and five-term mayor of Statesville NC.

Mr. Caldwell had been troubled with some kind of brain affection for more than a year before his death. He seemed to suffer very much at times, but a month or so before his decease he became unconscious for the greater part of the time, and when the end came he passed into eternity almost without a struggle. We have reason to believe that he had been a consistent member of the church at Back Creek for forty years or more. After he removed from the bounds of the congregation, he labored under almost insurperable difficulties in attention to public ordinances; still he continued to be with us occasionally, and seemed to enjoy the privilege exceedingly. Possessing as he did a generous charity, a prudent devotion to his own church was one of his most prominent characteristics. Too, he was a man of an enterprising turn of mind; and his efforts in the direction of earthly prosperity were generally crowned with success.

In regard to preparation for death, he said to a brother who stood by him, as he was able, day and night, like a sentinel at his post: "My mind is composed about that matter, I have made all required arrangements with my God and Saviour." His three sons, Rev. D.B. Caldwell being one of them, with their families, were about his bed, as far as circumstances would permit, in the last days of his life, ready for the demands of a peculiar affliction.

Mrs. Caldwell, her house, by the appointment of death, being left unto her desolate, will spend the short remnant of her days in the homes of her children, patiently awaiting a reunion with loved ones gone before, in the land where separation by death never transpires.

CHARLES ALLEN CALDWELL, died in Concord, N. C., on the 29th of May, 1889, in the sixty-third year of his age.

We have reason to believe that he had been a consistent member of the church at Back Creek for forty years or more. After he removed from the bounds of the congregation, he labored under almost insurmountable difficulties in attention to public ordinances; still he continued to be with us occasionally, and seemed to enjoy the privilege exceedingly. Possessing as he did a generous charity, a prudent devotion to his own church was one of his most prominent characteristics.
